Adapting the soft-shell green crab fishery in the US

Molting occurs May-July (males)



- Pilot production:
 - ~100 crabs/week from June-July in 2018/2019
- Sold to local restaurants for \$3/each (~\$25-30/lb)
- Restaurants put on menu for \$9/crab, sold out immediately every time
- Caveat: only ~15% of catch is pre-molt, even at height of season












Monitoring efforts

- Many different organizations collecting data on green crabs, but who is using it?
- Compile all data and create interactive website
- Tool for municipal shellfish programs, students, researchers, etc.
- Start with Kennebec region, but eventually expand?
